

#### Illinois



Gov. Bruce Rauner (R)

- 75.0% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- 36.1% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- 47,000 persons aged 16 to 20 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 649,500 persons aged 21 to 64 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 1,408,692 PwDs live in IL.3
- The employment gap between people with and without disabilities has decreased by 2.3% between 2010 and 2011.<sup>3</sup>
- 340, 098 people between 18 and 64 received SSDI or SSI benefits in IL in 2012.<sup>3</sup>
- In 2012, the total expenditure on SSDI benefits for PwDs in IL was \$4,477,308,000.3
- Voc. Rehab. obtained 5,324 jobs (out of 15,886 applicants) for PwDs in IL in 2012.<sup>2</sup>





## Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 16 to 20 in Illinois in 2012



## Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 21 to 64 in Illinois in 2012




