# New York State



- 73.3% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- ✤ 32.2% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- 68,800 persons aged 16 to 20 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 997,500 persons aged 21 to 64 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 2,171,581 civilians with a disability live in the community in NY.<sup>3</sup>
- The Employment Gap between PwDs and people without disabilities has decreased 0.7 % pts between 2010 and 2011.<sup>3</sup>
- 601,407 people ages 18-64 received SSDI or SSI benefits in the year 2012.<sup>3</sup>
- In 2012, NY's total expenditure on SSDI benefits for PwDs was \$8,018,808,000.3

Governor Andrew Cuomo \* Voc. Rehab. obtained 12,386 jobs for PwDs in NY in 2012.<sup>2</sup>


- Voc. Rehab. received 36,015 general applicants and 1,099 blind applicants in NY in 2012.<sup>3</sup>


